

Won't take political sanyas, will force BJP into obscurity: Mamata

Trinamool Congress chief Mamata Banerjee on Monday asserted that she would not take political 'sanyas' (retirement) and would continue fighting until the BJP was forced into obscurity.

In a Facebook Live, the former Chief Minister claimed that West Bengal's people had "understood the true face of the BJP within four months" of the change in government and alleged widespread intimidation.

"Those who think I will take 'sanyas' from politics simply because I am denied permission are mistaken. Our fight will not stop until the BJP itself is forced into political retirement," Banerjee said.

She alleged that police were filing cases against TMC workers and telling people not to support her faction.

Milk on pavement: Didi offers shelter

Kolkata: TMC chief Mamata Banerjee on Monday offered to help a pavement-dwelling family after West Bengal Urban Development and Municipal Affairs Minister Agnimitra Paul reprimanded a woman for heating milk for her child on a kerosene stove. The incident, captured in a viral video, drew criticism online and from the opposition.

"Cases have been filed against 12,000 to 14,000 people. With the help of some traitors and looters, people are being told to join the BJP," she said.

Banerjee also accused the BJP of orchestrating unrest at Jadavpur University following clashes between ABVP and Left students. She said the university emblem had been trampled and destroyed. Banerjee said she respected the students despite differences of opinion.

She alleged that the Census was a backdoor attempt to enforce the National Register

of Citizens (NRC), questioning whether information collected could later be used elsewhere.

On the Special Intensive Revision (SIR) of electoral rolls, Banerjee alleged that the exercise had illegally deleted "lakh" of genuine voters and said she would approach the Supreme Court again, if necessary, for their inclusion.

"The BJP won the election through looting," she said, adding: "Now, it is not the BJP's honeymoon period, it is their 'money-moon' phase."

Living together does not condone cruelty: HC

The Calcutta High Court upheld a decree of divorce granted by a family court in favour of a man, holding that stray incidents of living together as husband and wife during separation do not amount to condonation of cruelty. Noting that although the couple lived together for about five years, they separated and parted their ways for 11 years afterward, a division bench said that a court-referred mediation between the parties also failed.

"We come to the conclusion that the appellant-wife is guilty of mental cruelty to the husband, thus furnishing a valid ground for divorce," the bench comprising Justices Sabyasachi Bhattacharyya and Supratim Bhattacharya held.

BIFURCATION ROW | Satheesan seeks Railway consultations with state govt, stakeholders

Kerala CM asks for brakes on Palakkad

Kerala Chief Minister V D Satheesan on Monday urged Prime Minister Narendra Modi to put on hold the Railway Board's decision to transfer the Mangaluru area, including Ullal, from the Palakkad Division of Southern Railway to the Mysuru Division of South Western Railway from Oct 1.

In a letter to the PM, Satheesan sought his "personal intervention" to reconsider the decision after consultations with the Kerala government and other stakeholders.

The Railway Board communicated the decision on Aug 21. Satheesan said it had caused "serious concern" in Kerala as it was taken without prior consultation with the state government despite significant long-term implications for railway infrastructure and development, particularly in northern Kerala.

Protesters arrested, hunger strike planned on Onam day

Palakkad: Separate protests by the DYFI and Youth Congress against the proposed bifurcation of the Palakkad Railway Division turned violent on Monday, police said. DYFI activists breached police barricades at the Divisional Railway Manager's office and staged a sit-in against the proposal. Police arrested and removed them after around two hours. Youth Congress protesters were also arrested after refusing to disperse. The Railway Board's decision has triggered protests across Kerala, with Congress MPs announcing an Onam-day hunger strike outside the divisional railway office.

has been an integral part of the Palakkad Division for decades. The proposed transfer would take away Mangaluru Central, Mangaluru Junction and railway infrastructure linked to the Mangaluru port region, including Panambur.

He said Panambur handles substantial freight and container traffic and is an important revenue source for the Palakkad Division.

According to Satheesan, the Mangaluru area accounts

for more than 90 per cent of the division's freight revenue, estimated at around ₹650 crore, and contributes more than 50 per cent of its overall revenue of approximately ₹1,650 crore.

He said removing such a large revenue-generating territory would weaken the division's operational and financial strength and could affect infrastructure projects, new train services and passenger amenities in the Malabar region.

'Simultaneous polls in 2029 possible if states agree'

Simultaneous Lok Sabha and state assembly elections in 2029 are possible if Parliament amends the Constitution and states support the move, joint parliamentary panel chairman PP Chaudhary said on Monday.

He said if Parliament approves the constitutional amendment by 2028, implementation could begin that year. However, states would have to decide whether to dissolve their assemblies for elections alongside the Lok Sabha polls.

Classes in the IIT-Delhi were suspended on Monday amid student protests at the institute's Lecture Hall Complex following the alleged suicide of a 31-year-old MSc Physics student, officials said. The protesters demanded an independent investigation into the death and accountability of the officials found responsible. The 31-year-old MSc Physics student died on Saturday.

NAHAN (HP) Two children drown in HP rivulet

Two among five children who had gone to bathe in a rivulet in Sirmour district drowned while three children were rescued by the Puruwalla police with the help of local residents, police said on Monday.

Five children had gone to bathe in Jambukhala rivulet on Sunday evening. One suddenly went into deep water and started drowning. While trying to save him, the other child also drowned.
